COMES NOW JOSEPH JACKSON, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney in and for Thurston County, State of Washington, and respectfully moves the Court for an order dismissing the above-entitled action against the defendant, on the grounds and for the following reasons:

Between May 6, 2013 and May 29, 2013, the State made repeated attempts to contact the victim's family to set up defense interviews, but did not receive any response. The victim is residing in another jurisdiction within the State of Washington and the State requested that the jurisdiction where the victim resides make in person contact with the victim's family. This contact resulted in a response early on May 29, 2013. At that time, the State obtained a waiver for the Defense to speak with the medical witness and spoke with the victim's mother. Later in that week. Defense Attorney Richard Woodrow was able to interview the victim's mother telephonically. On Friday, May 31, 2013, the State spoke with the victim who expressed a willingness to go forward with prosecution, but displayed hesitation due to the emotional trauma of the event. On Tuesday, May 4, 2013, Defense Attorney Woodrow telephonically interviewed Anne Daly, MSN, the nurse from CARES Northwest, who is the State's medical witness. Today, the victim's family informed the State that the victim is emotionally unable to participate in a defense interview or trial. At this time, the State cannot confirm that all of the State's witness will be able to participate. Further, it appears in the best interest of the victim that the case not continue toward trial at this point due to the emotional state of the victim. While the State maintains that there is probable cause for the allegations in this case, the State cannot in good conscience put the victim through emotional trauma in order to hold the Defendant accountable. Therefore, it is in the interest of justice that the matter be dismissed without prejudice,
